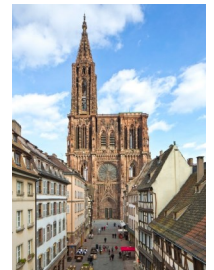
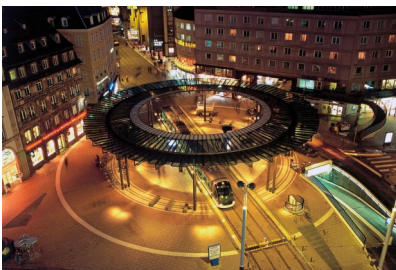


IScO / STK - excursion and seminar on regional culture:
